The Client agrees that this signed contract will be valid for all future services with CCATL. The Client agrees to reimburse and is fully accountable for any and all additional fees for CCATL to address emergency or veterinary care as well as any other unexpected supplies (including but not limited to: food, repairs, cleaning, transportation, supplies, medication). The Client is aware and understands that veterinary fees may be costly, especially if surgery or hospitalization is involved.

If the client requires the use of CCATL veterinary nursing services while away: The Client understands that CCATL is not a veterinarian and therefore will not hold CCATL to circumstances beyond their control. The Client understands that CCATL will only perform nursing care as instructed by a veterinarian and will not be responsible for decisions regarding the pets' health made by the veterinarian and owner.
